

# Future Frontiers Privacy Notice

This Privacy Notice ("Privacy Notice") describes the personal data that Future Frontiers (charity number: 1162470) ("Future Frontiers", "our", "us" or "we") collects from:

- Current and prospective school and business contacts ("Contacts");
- Current and prospective donors and supporters ("Supporters");
- email subscribers ("Stay Connected Subscribers"); and
- visitors to our website ("Website Visitors").

Future Frontiers is responsible for how and why your personal data is being processed. Therefore, for the purposes of the "UK GDPR" (i.e., the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 as it forms part of UK law), Future Frontiers is the 'controller' of your personal data.

#### What personal data does Future Frontiers collect about you?

We may collect, depending on the nature of your connection to us, the following data:

- Contact data, such as your first and last name, school/business name, e-mail, phone number, regional location and/or address, partnership status.
- Communications data that we exchange with you, including when you contact us with questions
  or feedback, and regarding your connection to Future Frontiers and your communication
  preferences.
- Marketing data, such as your preferences for receiving our marketing communications and details about your engagement with them.
- Automatically collected data that we log about you, your computer or mobile device, when you
  visit our website, including your interaction over time with the website and other online
  activity data.
- Publicly available data about you.
- Other data that you provide to us.

#### Why does Future Frontiers process your personal data and what is our legal basis?

We use your personal data for the purposes listed below. In respect of each of the purposes for which we use your personal data, the UK GDPR requires us to ensure that we have a "legal basis" for that use. We rely on the following legal bases:

- Where we need to perform a contract, we are about to enter into or have entered into with you ("Contractual Necessity").
- Where it is necessary for our legitimate interests and your interests and fundamental rights do not override those interests ("Legitimate Interests").
- Where we have your specific consent to carry out the processing for the purpose in question ("Consent").
- Where we need to comply with a legal or regulatory obligation ("Compliance with Law").



## Special categories of data

We ask that you not provide us with any sensitive personal information (e.g., social security numbers, information related to racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religion or other beliefs, health, biometrics or genetic characteristics, criminal background or trade union membership). If you provide us with any sensitive personal information, you must consent to our processing and use of such sensitive personal information in accordance with this Privacy Notice. If you do not consent to our processing and use of such sensitive personal information, you must not submit such sensitive personal information to us.

## Who do we share your personal data with?

We may share your personal data:

- with third-party service providers;
- to comply with regulatory and/or legal requirements; and/or to take legal action.

#### International data transfers

We may transfer your personal data to countries or territories outside of the UK (including by transferring your personal data to further recipients in the U.S.). Whenever we do this, we will make sure that we implement a data transfer mechanism to appropriately safeguard your personal data.

#### How do we keep your personal data secure?

We employ a number of technical and organisational safeguards designed to protect the personal data we collect. However, security risk is inherent in all internet and information technologies and we cannot guarantee the security of your personal data.

#### How long will we keep your personal data?

We will retain your personal data for as long as is necessary or permitted in view of the purposes for which it was collected, as described in this Privacy Notice. The criteria used to establish our retention periods include but are not limited to: (i) the duration of our programme; (ii) whether there is a legal obligation to which we are subject; or (iii) whether retention is advisable based on





our legal position (for example, applicable statutes of limitations, litigation or regulatory investigations).

## What rights do you have in relation to your personal data?

The UK GDPR gives you certain rights regarding your personal data in certain circumstances. You may ask us to take the following actions in relation to your personal data that we hold:

- Access. Provide you with information about our processing of your personal data and give you access to your personal data.
- Correct. Update or correct inaccuracies in your personal data.
- **Delete**. Delete your personal data.
- Transfer. Transfer a machine-readable copy of your personal data to you or a third party of your choice.
- **Restrict**. Restrict the processing of your personal data.
- Object. Object to our reliance on our Legitimate Interests as the basis of our processing of your personal data.
- **Opt-out**. Stop sending you direct marketing communications. You may continue to receive service-related and other non-marketing emails.
- Consent withdrawal. Where we rely on your Consent and/or explicit Consent to process your personal data you may withdraw that Consent at any time.
